UPC SPEAKS OUT ON THE MISINFORMATION OVER THE COURT RULING

1. Uganda Peoples Congress first of all is a law abiding party that respects Court Rulings. UPC will also not stand by and accept misinformation. It is unfortunate that soon after the Friday Court Ruling, the UPC former Vice President, Joseph Bossa has been hosted on Radio one and CBS where he opted to mislead listeners to the effect that Court ordered the eviction of Hon. Akena's Leadership from Uganda House. Whereas Otunnu, Bossa and MOF wanted the said Court to throw us out of Uganda House, it is important to note that Court did not issue such an order to evict our leadership as some media houses have been misled to believe.
2. Secondly, it is important to note that Court was more interested in seeing the party resolve its conflicts internally rather than pronouncing winners or losers via court rulings, hence the reason not to award costs against any party.
Court maintained that the Party District Conference Nominations were held constitutionally.

It is against this background that the current Party leadership is planning to file a Notice of Intention to Appeal together with an application for proceedings within fourteen (14) days as required by law.

We, therefore, call upon all UPC Members to stay put and ignore any empty threats by those ill-disposed to the Party.
